There are no known utility conflicts within the project limits. All utilities have been relocated and confirmed no-conflicts with the anticipated project.

Project activities **will not** occur within one-half mile of a railroad track.

Please be advised that it will be the contractor's responsibility to call in for the AZ811/Blue Stake ticket and required utility markings. In addition, potholing to confirm the locations of any facilities within the project footprint will be the contractor's responsibility as well. We ask that these requirements are clearly conveyed to the contractor prior to the start of any excavating activities.

If there is a change in the project termini or work is to be added outside the original scope, MCDOT's Utilities Coordination Section **must be contacted immediately** to re-evaluate for potential utility conflicts and mitigation strategies please.

Please be aware that this letter includes all known utilities as provided by Blue Stake, relocation audit potholing and the maps/information provided by these known utility companies. Service Drops and Utility crossings are not always identified by Blue Stake services or on as-built drawings and will be dealt with on a case by case basis if they are discovered during construction activity.
